

THE PEOPLE BEHIND THE ACADEMY

In our newsletters in 2012, we will profile the key people behind the Saints Player Academy.

This month we are profiling Jaymie Graham – Development Coach (Leadership & Welfare).



Jaymie Graham, who has experienced the highs and lows of being a professional footballer, is responsible for Leadership and Welfare within the Saints Player Academy.

Graham, 28, played 37 games with West

Coast over four seasons in an injury-ravaged career.

He received West Coast's outstanding clubman award in 2008, honouring his contribution to the club and the community.

Jaymie continued his evolution as a development expert with his WAFL club South Fremantle after his retirement two years ago.

The former South Fremantle captain has said that the horrific knee injury that forced him into retirement ultimately set him on the path to coaching and accepting the new development role at St Kilda.

"This is an exciting opportunity for me, I'm very impressed with St Kilda's new approach to player development and welfare," Jaymie said upon his appointment.

"Football is a tough industry and it's important a player is armed with the tools they need, both mentally and physically, to deal with any obstacles or challenges they may face."

"This development coaching role is perfectly down my alley. I do want to expand on my coaching experiences and hopefully one day get into a more senior role, an assistant role and look at being a coach in the future."

Jaymie's football career started in the Kalgoorlie league with Mines Rovers, with promise prompting a move to Perth.

Jaymie and five of his siblings were raised by their grandparents, former horse trainer Peter Graham and his wife Robyn, after his mother Trudy's life was ruined by drugs.

But through a complicated set of circumstances five year-old Candy remained in foster care – a situation Jaymie was

determined to rectify. In 2008 Jaymie achieved his goal, becoming his sisters' full time carer.

Jaymie is continuing his teaching degree and will also have a match day role with the Saints VFL affiliate side, the Sandringham Zebras, as assistant coach to Simon McPhee.
